# LIVING EXPENSES

#### Accommodation

The average home rental price for whole Istanbul about 5-6 USD per square meters, which means a 100  $m^2$  flat renting price is between 500-600 USD per month.

## **Food Expenses**

Food expenses in average is 200 USD per month.

#### Transportation

Using public transportation is the cheapest way to get around Istanbul. It is also safe and convenient. For students there is a special card which costs 7-10 USD per month.

### **Household Bills**

- Electric: 20-30 USD per month.
- Water and Sewerage: 20 USD per month.
- Natural Gas for locally heating up your flat: 65-85 USD per month (in winter months).
- Telephone, Internet, Digital TV and GSM: As there is competition between the major teleccommunications and entertainment companies in Turkey, you may buy all in one "Telephone + Internet + Digital TV" packages for about 15-25 USD per month and GSM for 8-10 per month.

## In Total

Living expenses in Istanbul per month are equivalent approximately to 800-1000 USD.
